<b>KS2 – KS4 (Year 7 to 11) Progress 8 of pupils</b>	+0.4	-0.15	Progress from Year 7 to 11 is well above the majority of schools in England. Students at Globe, on average, gain almost half a grade more than they are expected to, due to an outstanding commitment to quality teaching & learning and a culture of high aspiration.
<b>Year 11 Average Attainment 8 of pupils</b>	4.78	4.46	The average attainment in Year 11 is a C to B grade. This is above the national required benchmark by over half a grade.
<b>Percentage of pupils achieving a <b>Grade 4</b> or better in English and Maths GCSE at the end of Year 11</b>	68%	59%	Percentage achieving English and Maths GCSE benchmark is in above the average across England's schools by 9%.
<b>Percentage of pupils achieving a <b>Grade 5</b> or better in English and Maths GCSE at the end of Year 11</b>	46%	39.6%	Percentage achieving English and Maths GCSE benchmark is in above the average across England's schools by 6.4%.
<b>Percentage of pupils who achieved the English Baccalaureate</b>	37%	21.9%	Percentage achieving the English Baccalaureate (4/C plus) is above the average across England's schools by 15%.
