At Ark Globe Academy Primary, we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of the children. Our Primary School Sport's Funding will enable us to continue and extend our provision through employing an additional sports professional, entering into more competitive sports competitions and training our staff to deliver in-house quality PE sessions.

What is the Sports Premium?

The government is providing funding of £150 million per annum for the academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15, 2015/16 and 2016/17 to provide new and substantial primary school sport funding. The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to Primary School headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. Each school will receive £8,000 plus an extra £5 per pupil each year for the next two years - here at Ark Globe Academy Primary that will mean around £10,000 a year. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

Purpose of the funding

Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Possible uses of the funding include:

- Hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE
- Paying for professional development opportunities in PE/sport
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- Running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games
- Buying quality assured professional development modules or material for PE/sport
- Providing places for pupils on after school sport clubs and residential visits

The money must be used so that:

- all children benefit regardless of sporting ability
- that the most-able children are given the opportunity to compete in advanced tournaments
- that staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development

The Sports funding will be used at Ark Globe Academy Primary to:

- support and engage the least active children through new or additional sports clubs during the school day
- increase the amount of competitive sport in which our children participate – e.g Lambeth and Southwark Football Association
- contribute towards the cost of a full time additional PE teacher to teach all year groups from Year 1 to Year 6 throughout the week
- purchase equipment to offer access to new sports and physical activities as relevant
- purchase a new Primary PE curriculum (Real PE)

Impact:

- We will evaluate the impact of the Sports Premium funding as part of our normal self-evaluation
- We will look at how well we use our Sport Premium to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sporting provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.
- Measuring the impact of the activities provided with sports premium funding can be achieved in different ways. We will look at progress in PE as well as other areas of development such as self-esteem, confidence and the numbers of pupils involved in sporting activities in and out of school.

What we did	Cost	Impact
Employed an additional full time PE teacher	£30,000	Through specialised teaching, pupils' enjoyment of PE and fitness levels increased. Level of skill witnessed was significantly higher than prior to the employment of a sports coach. Through high level coaching, teachers' knowledge and understanding increased and were better equipped to teach the pupils.
Joined the Lambeth and Southwark Football league	£600	Continued with a Yr 5 and 6 school football team. Boys were able to play competitively and learnt the skills needed. Increase in confidence and teamwork skills. Team were able to recognise how to play as a team and demonstrated high levels of cooperation and through captaincy, leadership.
Increase in playground equipment ie additional tables / markings etc	£1000	Pupils behaviour improved, social skills taught effectively. Pupils level of enjoyment increased. Areas were zoned to ensure effective adult support.
Real PE Curriculum	£2000	Pupils were taught to develop high level skills in balance, agility and coordination which form the foundations of all sport and physical activity. Pupils became physically literate and overall fitness will improve.

		Teachers' knowledge of how to teach PE increased through effective and progressive scheme of work.
Real Gym training	£265	Head of Secondary PE trained up to teach Real Gym which was disseminated down to all teachers of PE.
