	<u>Task 1:</u> Contextual research for Streetcar Named Desire
	<ul> <li>Before you read the play you must find out about: <ul> <li>Tennessee Williams: 10 interesting points about his life that might apply to the play</li> <li>Louisiana and New Orleans: where is it? What is interesting about the place? What interesting facts can you find out about its history. You should have at least 20 interesting ideas.</li> <li>The Southern Gentleman and the Southern Belle. What are these and what characterises them? What are southern manners.</li> <li>What is 'Elysian Fields'?</li> <li>What is a 'Tragedy'?</li> <li>What can you find out about the play before you read it?</li> </ul> </li> <li>Task 2 <ul> <li>You will now need to read the play.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	For your presentation: - Summarise the context - Summarise the play - Explain how the context connects to the play.
	B. Frankenstein by Mary Shelley
	Each bullet point should be at least a paragraph long. Do not copy and paste off the Internet – you should be summarising your research.

	<ul> <li>Who were Agrippa and Magnus?</li> <li>What was the Enlightenment?</li> <li>What was happening in art in the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Centuries?</li> <li>What technological advances had been made before the 18<sup>th</sup> century?</li> <li>What was happening in medicine in the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> centuries?</li> <li>What were gravediggers?</li> </ul> CONTEXT B – In word document form with headings <ul> <li>What is the gothic genre and what are its characteristics?</li> <li>Who was Horace Walpole?</li> <li>What is romantic literature?</li> <li>Who was Percy Bryce Shelley?</li> </ul>

Resources required:	Most of this research should be done on the Internet or at a library.  - A copy of the play and the novel. These can be found with me or at a library.
