Admissions FAQ

What's the criteria for applying to your school?

Ark Globe Academy is a non-selective, all-through school with no religious affiliations and serves children of all abilities. When we admit students, we prioritise children with statements of special educational needs. Please refer to our website for our Admissions Policy.

Does this school allow muslim girl with hijab or headscarf?

Yes. All headwear worn for religious reasons must be black. More information on school uniform can be found on our website, on the 'School Uniform' page.

Will there be any future opportunities for tours of the school?

Currently, we are unable to provide school tours due to Covid-19, however from 21 October 2020, there will be a virtual tour video available on our website. If we are able to host tours at our academy in the future, we will announce this on our website.

Does the school require a test for admission?

Your child will not require a test to support with their application. We do, however, assess students when they start with us so we know how best to support your child.

How do you identify areas to develop and report this to parents to support our children?

Twice a year, you will be required to attend the Student Appraisal Day. This is a meeting with your child's Learning Family tutor where you will be given a full academic and behavioural report on your child and you will set targets for your child to achieve.

Do you have halal meals?

All meat supplied at Ark Globe Academy is sourced from halal butchers.

Is there any prayer room?

Yes. The prayer room is available for students over lunchtime.

What are the dates to go to the school?

Our term dates are available on our website under 'School Life'.

How many students are in your school?

The Primary school has places for 60 pupils each year in two classes and 50 part time or full time Nursery places. The Secondary school has a Pupil Admission Number of 180 pupils in Year 7 for 6 classes.

What is done to support transition to Secondary School?

We run a range of activities as part of our Transition Programme, including a week-long Summer School, a Taster Day, tests, a dedicated transition web page which hosts videos and presentations for new Year 7 students, and an Administrative Evening where parents are able to come to the academy to complete their admissions forms.

When do we receive the forms to submit admissions to your school?

Applications must be done by Southwark Council website if you live in Southwark Borough. If you live in a different borough, this must be done through their website. Applications for Secondary Schools must be submitted by 31 October 2020.
