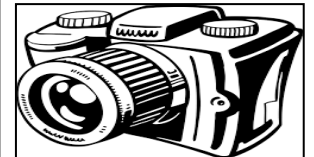

## School Photos

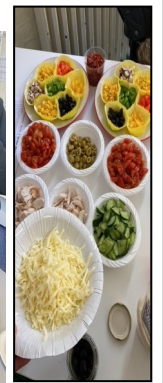
School photos for individuals and siblings will take place this week on Tuesday 2 and Wednesday 3 November 2021.

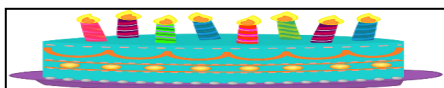
