Your child will also be taught by our PE Coach—Mr Malachi and Ms Brooks—our Art teacher—whilst Mrs Sanders is absent from school.

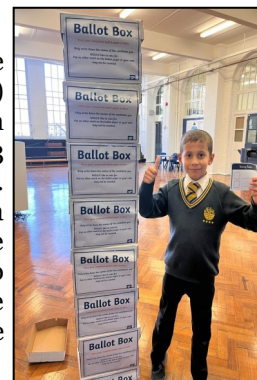
### Children In Need 2022
