



Coronavirus Catch Up Funding 2020-21

Context to Funding

The coronavirus pandemic led to an enforced school closure from March 2020-July 2020. School closure had a negative impact on students, academically and pastorally. Nationally, there has been a regression in attainment and an increase in mental health concerns.

Ark Globe Academy has been allocated £90, 120 to help close the gaps that have arisen as a result of closure.

The main objectives are to increase numeracy and literacy and the focus is primarily on school leavers.
