School Uniform

Pupils returned to school looking very smart, thank you for ensuring the children wear the correct uniform. Please be aware that we now have a new system in place to ensure that 100% of our children wear the correct uniform—this includes PE kit as we do have a very small number of children who persistently wear the incorrect items.

1. If children **do not** have the correct items on (ties and shoes are the main issues currently), they will be asked to see Ms Colburn.
2. She will issue a 24 hour 'pass' and children will be asked to wear the correct item the following day. However ties will be given out on the day as we have spare ones.
3. If pupils wear the same incorrect item the following day, they will be given the item from our school stock—this does include shoes.

We know uniform is very expensive, especially if you have more than one child in school, so if there are any money worries, we can purchase the uniform piece and then put together a payment plan for you. Please let Ms Colburn know and we will look into how we can help.


