This half term, your child's relationships and health education lessons will be based on the theme of Goals and Dreams. The children have received an assembly today around the topic, so please do




Year 6 Unicorn Theatre Work

Reading Age Assessments

Next week, pupils in Year 2—6 will be taking their third and final NGRT reading age assessment for this academic year. This assessment is completed on a laptop with some pupils working in small groups or 1:1 to support them a little. The assessments will require the children to read various sentences and match a word to the space as well as some phonological assessments for our less fluent readers. Older pupils will be asked to read parts of a text and fit the words or answer questions about what they have read. The children have taken this style of assessment previously and have done very well. The results of this assessment provides you with a reading age which will be shared with you in your child's final report which you will receive in July.
