Remote Home Learning

As you may be aware, our pupils in school and at home are accessing the same work.

All pupils from Nursery to Year 6 have a Seesaw account where our teachers are uploading new video lessons by 9am every day. Pupils in Reception to Year 6 are expected to access their work on a daily

basis and complete **4 lessons every day** in the following subjects:

Maths
Arithmetic (not Reception)
Reading or RWI Phonics
Writing

Pupils should complete work in the exercise books sent home, take a photo and upload it **or** they can complete the work directly onto Seesaw. Please ensure pupils do this by **4pm** please if possible. Teachers and co-teachers are tracking the work completed so we can see just how much pupils are doing. 
