

**Keywords:**

<b>Projection</b>	The volume and clarity of your voice
<b>Pace</b>	The speed of movement/speech
<b>Split-Stage</b>	A stage split in two or more sections to highlight a different location or time period happening at the same time on stage
<b>Tone</b>	The emotion in your voice e.g. angry tone, sad tone, happy tone etc.
<b>Characterisation</b>	The creation of a character – voice, physicality, facial expressions
<b>Emphasis</b>	To stress a word/short phrase for dramatic effect
<b>Dramatic Pause</b>	A short break in a speech used for dramatic effect
<b>Monologue</b>	A long speech delivered by one actor
