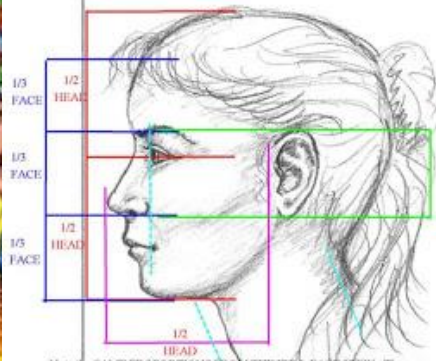




BASIC PROFILE PROPORTIONS



Note the SAME PROPORTIONS FROM THE FULL FACE VIEW. The back of the NOSE is in line with the front of the Eye. The distance from the tip of the nose to the back of the jaw and the front of the ear, is 1/2 the HEAD HEIGHT. Also notice how the neck tips FORWARD. Pay particular attention to the shape of the ear, both in outline and inside details.

Scale and proportion in art are closely related and both deal with the size and the relationship of things to other things.

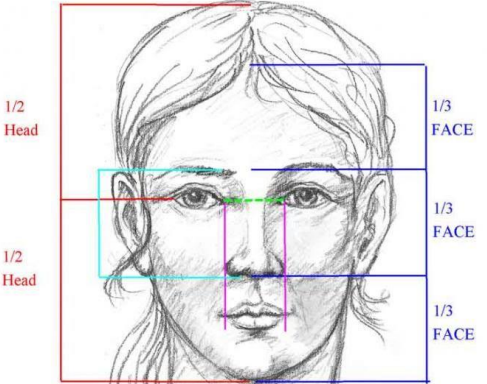

BASIC FULL FACE PROPORTIONS



The eyes are halfway between the top of the head and the bottom of the chin. The FACE is divided into 3 parts: from hairline to eyebrow, from eyebrow to bottom of nose, from nose to chin. The distance between the eyes (In green) is approximately the width of one eye. This is the same width of the nose (and to some extent, the mouth at rest). The ear length is from the eyebrow to the bottom of the nose. (In light blue)
